

Safety Drill 11.13.18

Ashley Parents:

The State of Michigan requires school districts to run safety drills for students. This includes fire drills, tornado drills, evacuation drills, and lockdown drills. This year we have already held drills including fire drills, a lockdown and barricade drill and a tornado drill.

Tuesday, November 13 at about 10:15, we will be conducting an evacuation informational drill. The goal is to make students aware of the location they should go if we had to evacuate the building. The evacuation location is the community center on the main street (Sterling Street). The community center is the red building. This will be more of a short field trip than a drill. Students will be walking to the building with staff members. They will not enter the building as it is being set up for Country Christmas. Students will be aware of the drill before it happens and they will be allowed to dress for the weather.

In an actual event that requires evacuation, parents will be directed to the Remenar building, which is the white building across the street from the community center. In an actual event, parents will be reunited with their children in a manner that allows us to account for all students.
